#### MOVING FROM NAPKIN DRAWINGS TO INITIAL PROTOTYPES







- Enables NM clinicians to move from "napkin drawings" to initial prototypes
- Supports initial prototyping build with external firm
- Facilitates initial conversations and interest among clinicians, industry partners, investors
- Provides potential next steps through Kellogg classes, mHUB, other alternative resources
- Offers patentability assessment for IP protection, if selected and funding support for IP prosecution and negotiating licensing agreements




